The primary bedroom includes a three-piece ensuite. The kitchen was renovated in 2018 with additional oak cabinetry, and there is also a large pantry providing even more storage options. The outdoor space is perfect for summer entertaining, with a large cement patio and the ability to connect a BBQ to gas. Additional features of the home include large storage under the third floor (More spray-in foam was also added here), new shingles installed by Heritage Roofing in 2019, and two sump pumps with battery backup.
